- Digital signature certificate (DSC): Intending bidders must have DSC (Digital signature certificate) for submission of their bids online through Government e-Auction system (https://eauction.gov.in) to participate in the competitive bidders.
- 2. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD): Bidders must deposit 10% of the total auction value as EMD via Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque from any nationalised bank, in favour of the Superintendent of Police, Jhargram. Failure to deposit EMD will lead to disqualification. No interest will be paid on EMD. If the successful bidder backs out or fails to take delivery, the EMD will be forfeited.
