TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1) The licensee/applicant must remain present during the entire programme and will be responsible for any violation.
- 2) The organizer shall submit names and contact numbers of Nodal persons who will accompany the event and will assist police in case of any emergency.
- 3) The number of participants must match the number declared in the application.
- 4) The rally/procession/meeting must be conducted peacefully.
- 5) Loudspeakers, if used, must follow the limits set by the Calcutta High Court and WB Pollution Control Board.
- 6) Loudspeakers in open air or vehicle horns cannot be used near hospitals, nursing homes, courts, universities, colleges, and schools (Silence Zones).
- 7) No fireworks are allowed during the programme.
- 8) Participants cannot carry weapons such as sticks, spears, firearms, or swords.
- 9) Speeches that provoke violence, use abusive language, or incite disturbance are not allowed.
- 10) The rally/procession/meeting must not block traffic, entry to buildings, or emergency vehicles like ambulances and fire brigades.
- 11) Participants must not damage public property, attack government servants, or break any law.
- 12) The event should not cause inconvenience to the public.
- 13) Participants must follow State Government's Health Advisories.
- 14) Vehicles/tableaux in the rally must follow traffic rules, signals, and one-way directions, and move at a safe speed.
- 15) The organizer must provide enough volunteers to assist the police.

- 16) Participants must avoid environmental pollution and follow directions of the Calcutta High Court, NGT, and WB Pollution Control Board.
- 17) Necessary NOCs must be obtained from landowners and utility services in advance.
- 18) The land used must be restored, and all waste/garbage must be cleaned immediately after the programme at the organizer's cost.
- 19) No temporary gallery or stage for seating participants is allowed.
- 20) Adequate drinking water must be arranged.
- 21) The venue and nearby area must be kept clean, and no plastic or waste material should be left behind.
- 22) Trees and greenery must not be damaged.
- 23) Vehicles must not be parked in "No Parking Zones."
- 24) All existing rules and regulations must be followed strictly.
- 25) Bike rallies/processions are strictly prohibited.
- 26) Children should not be allowed to participate unless the programme is specifically children-oriented.
- 27) DJs are not allowed in rallies/processions.
- 28) Participants must obey any orders/directions given by Jhargram Police during the programme.
- 29) Jhargram Police reserves the right to withdraw permission at any time if required.
